

Parkinson's is the second most common neurodegenerative disease after Alzheimer's disease. Today, nearly 1 million people in the United States are living with Parkinson's Disease, and in only 7 years, this number is expected to rise to 1.2 million\*. To help the growing number of adults who are diagnosed with Parkinson's and other neurological disorders live a full life, John Knox Village is expanding its Outpatient Therapy Clinic to further enhance its Parkinson's programming.

The outpatient therapy clinic has reached capacity at its current location. Gala proceeds will enable the service to expand its treatment space – creating more room to provide treatment and support to patients with Parkinson's disease as well as patients recovering from surgery or injuries and others seeking physical, occupational and/or speech therapy treatments. Funds will be used to purchase new therapy equipment and outfit therapy rooms and office space.

Village Outpatient Therapy is the only single-site clinic in Eastern Jackson County where every therapist (physical, occupational and speech) is certified in Parkinson's-specific therapy treatments. Working as a holistic, interdisciplinary team, the therapists provide tailored treatment plans that target the whole person to improve symptoms and help maintain balance, mobility and activities of daily living.
